

These precautions are important for safe usage. Be sure to follow them and use the product correctly.

Symbols and Meanings

WARNING Incorrect use may result in death or serious injury.

CAUTION

May result in injury or property damage.

The following symbols are used to indicate important safety instructions for the use of the product.



This symbol indicates a prohibited use of the product.



This symbol indicates that specific actions are required to use the product.

- This product is classified as Class 1 Equipment and must be earthed.
- The power cable is 0.62m long. The device shall be installed near an accessible outlet. Please see the recommendation in the installation guide.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Use the new hose set included with this equipment. Do not use old water supply hoses.



WARNING

Do not touch the power plug with wet hands.

Doing so may cause an electrical shock.

Neither water nor cleaning agents may come in contact with the main unit and the plug.

- Doing so may cause fire, electrical shock, heat or short circuit.
- Doing so may damage the product resulting in injury or water damage.



Never disassemble, repair or alter.

- Doing so may cause fire, electrical shock, heat, short circuit or permanent damage. Do not install the product on vehicles such as wheeled vehicles or boats.
- Doing so may cause fire, electric shock, short circuit or malfunction.
- The toilet seat, toilet lid, main unit or other parts may come loose and fall off, resulting in injury.

WARNING

Do not use if a malfunction VICLEAN® occurs.

- Always keep the plugs separated and the switches on the distribution board in the OFF position.
- Close the water shut-off valve to stop water supply.

Possible malfunctions:

- Water is leaking from a pipe or the main unit.
- The product is cracked or broken.
- The product makes a strange noise or emits a strange odour.
- The product emits smoke.
- The product is abnormally hot.
- The toilet seat cushion is out of place.
- Continued use after malfunction could cause a fire, electric shock, heat, short circuit, injury or water damage.

Only use tap water or potable well water (underground water). Do not use seawater, industrial water or rainwater for the water supply.

Doing so may cause irritation to the skin and malfunction.



Do not touch the power plug during thunderstorms.

Doing so may cause an electrical shock.

The water supply hose may not come in contact with the plug.

Doing so may cause condensation resulting in a fire, electrical shock, overheating or a short circuit.

Do not do anything that may damage the power cord, power plug.

Do not strike, yank, twist, excessively bend, damage, alter, or heat the electrical cords. Also, do not place anything heavy on, bind or pinch the electrical cords.

• Using a damaged electrical cord may result in electrical shock, short circuit and a fire.

Do not use a loose or faulty electrical plug.

Doing so may cause fire or short circuit.

Do not use any outlets or wiring equipment beyond its specified rating.

Do not use any power supply other than the one specified. AC 220V - 240V, 50Hz

Doing so may cause fire or excessive heat.

Make save not to splash water, detergents or urine to the power supply.

Doing so may cause an electrical shock.



N WARNING

To reduce the danger of burns, death from electric shock, fire or other human injury:

 Do not use the product if the power cable or plug is faulty, if it is not working properly, if it has fallen to the ground or was damaged or it has fallen into water. Return the product to Villeroy & Boch AG for examination and repair.



- Never block the air openings of the product or place it on a soft surface, such as a bed or a couch, where the air openings could be blocked. Keep the air openings free of lint, hair or a similar material.
- Never use it while sleepy or drowsy.
- Never drop or insert anything into any opening or hose.
- Do not use it outdoors where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.

Do not bend or distort the nozzle.

• Doing so may cause product damage and performance reduction.

Do not place anything on the warm air dryer or drape clothes over it.

• Doing so may cause burns, electrical shock or malfunction.

Keep cigarettes and other open flames away from the product. Do not place a heater near the product.

• Failure to do so may cause fire.

Beware of irritation or burn

- Improper use of the toilet seat may cause irritation or burn.
 When sitting for a long time on the toilet seat, switch the toilet seat temperature adjustment to OFF.
 Should one of the groups listed below use the heated toilet seat or the hot air dryer, the toilet seat temperatures adjustment should be switched to OFF and the dryer temperature to "low".
- Young children, the aged and other users unable to set the temperature appropriately themselves.
- The ill, physically disabled and others who do not have freedom of movement.
- Those using any medicines that cause drowsiness (sleeping or cold medicine), those who have been drinking heavily, anyone severely fatigued and anyone else liable to fall asleep.

To reduce the danger of burns, death from electric shock, fire or other human injury:

- Close supervision is necessary when this product is used by or near children or handicapped individuals
- Use this product only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use accessories not recommended by the manufacturer.
- Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- Connect this product to a properly earthed outlet only.
- The tank should only be filled with water.



↑ WARNING

This is an electrical product. Do not install it anywhere water is likely to get on the product or anywhere with humidity high enough that water is likely to form on the surface of this product. If the product is located in a bathroom, install a fan or ventilation unit and ensure good air flow through the bathroom.

Failure to do so may cause fire or electrical shock.

Always connect to the cold water supply VICLEAN.

Connecting to hot water supply may result in burns and equipment damage.

Electrical power supply should be established by qualified electrical personnel.

Check that it is appropriately earthed.

- If the ground is not installed, if there is a breakdown or electrical current leak, the lack of a ground could cause electrical shock.
- For the ground, use copper wire with a earth resistance of 100 Ω max. and a diameter of 1.6 mm min.
- If there is no ground installed, ask the contractor who did the installation to install the ground.

Make sure that a properly earthed (3-pole) plug is available.

 Failure to use an earthed outlet could cause electrical shock in the event of a malfunction or short circuit.



Check whether the outlets for power supply meet the following requirements.

- Failure to do so may cause fire or electrical shock.
 - a. Apply a current to the outlet (or device) through a differential residual current device (RCD) whose release current does not exceed 30 mA.
 - b. Install the outlet (or device) and its wiring plug at least 0.60 m away from the outside of the shower tub or bathtub.
 - c. Check that the wiring for a. and b. above is complete. If the wiring has not been completed, ask the contractor who did the installation to do it.

Insert the power plug securely into the outlet.

Check that the power cord is connected.

- Failure to do so may cause fire, heat or short circuit.
- When installing this product, observe the local laws and regulations regarding installation.

To unplug, hold the plug, not the cord.

- Do not pull out plug by the cord.
- Pulling on the cord may cause damage and result in fire or heat.

Do not use wet hands to insert or remove power plug.

Doing so may cause an electrical shock.

If the cable is damaged, do not take any risks! Have the repair department or equivalent specialist replace it.



NARNING



Before, cleaning, servicing or inspecting the product, always place the switch on the distribution board to OFF (except for use of "Nozzle cleaning").

• Failure to do so may cause electrical shock or malfunction.



CAUTION

Do not use the product if the main unit is unstable.

- Doing so may cause the main unit to come loose and fall, resulting in injury.
- If there is back flash in the main unit, consult the installer, seller or the contact listed on the back cover of this manual.

If the product is damaged, do not touch the damaged section.

- Failure to do so may cause electrical shock or malfunction.
- Replace damaged element immediately.

Do not apply strong force, mechanical shock, step on or stand on the toilet seat, toilet lid or main unit. Also do not place any heavy object on the toilet seat, toilet lid or main unit.

- Doing so may cause cracking or cause the main unit to come loose and fall, resulting in injury.
- Doing so may damage the product and cause injury or water damage.



Do not lift up this product by the toilet seat or lid. Do not raise the toilet seat or lid while objects are resting on top of the toilet.

Doing so may cause the main unit to come loose and fall, resulting in injury.

To reduce the danger of death from electric shock:

- Do not use while bathing.
- Do not place or store the product where it could fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- Do not put in or drop into water or other liquid.
- Do not try to recover the product if it has fallen into water. Switch the breaker on the distribution board to OFF immediately.

To prevent a sudden water leak, do not remove the water supply hose or clean the filter when the shut-off valve is open.

Doing so will cause water to spurt out. (Refer to page 32: Cleaning the filter)

Do not fold or crush the water supply hose; do not damage by cutting with a sharp object.

Doing so may cause water leaks.



CAUTION

If a water leak should occur, always close the shut-off valve. When the ambient temperature is likely to drop to 0°C or lower, prevent damage to the pipes and hoses due to freezing.

- Frozen water pipes could cause the main unit and the pipes to break, resulting in a water leak.
- Regulate the room temperature to prevent the pipes and hoses from freezing during cold months.
- Drain the water.

When not using VICLEAN[®] over an extended period of time, drain the water out of the main unit and the water supply hose after closing the water shut-off valve.



- Switch the breaker on the distribution board to OFF.
- Leaving the power on may cause fire or heat.

When using the product again, allow the product to refill with water first (see page 48: Notes on filling with water).

 Otherwise, the water in the tank might become contaminated and cause skin inflammation or other problems.

When installing the water filter, make sure that it is securely tightened in its proper position.

Failure to securely tighten it may cause water leaks.

Operational Precautions

For prevention of malfunctions

 Do not block the body sensor, the remote control transmitter and receiver.

About the body sensors

Two types of body sensors are used.

Body sensor A detects changes inheat.

- Detection may be difficult when the room temperature exceeds 30°C, such as in the summertime.
- When sunlight is directly on the sensor area or a heater is used in the bathroom, the sensor may detect incorrectly due to the heat, resulting in the automatic operation of functions such as auto lid opening and closing.

Body sensor B detects when someone stands in front of the bidet toilet.

 Body sensor B emits an infra-red beam as shown in the figure. People who move through the beam are detected by the sensor (sensor detection may be difficult if the toilet is used by smaller people such as children).




Body sensor A

Seat switch

 When you sit on the toilet seat, the seat switch turns ON, enabling you to use various features. (A click sound is heard when the seat switch is ACTIVATED).



Sit back on the toilet seat.

 The seat switch will not turn on unless you sit on the seat properly.







- When a child uses VICLEAN[®], the seat switch may not be ACTIVATED by their light body weight.
- This seat switch creates a gap between the soft-closing device and the toilet.

For prevention of damage

Do not lean against the toilet lid.

Problem Prevention

- Switch the breaker on the distribution board to OFF.
- A toilet seat cover or a toilet lid cover cannot be used. (The body sensors or seat switch may not function properly.)



Operational Precautions

- Do not urinate on the main unit, toilet seat or nozzle.
 - (Doing so may cause pink or brown stains or a malfunction.)
- Do not apply strong forces to the control panel of the remote control.
- Do not expose to direct sunlight. (Doing so may cause changes in colour, irregular seat temperature, remote control malfunction or VICLEAN[®] malfunction due to the change in temperature.)
- Do not use radios, etc. near VICLEAN[®].
 VICLEAN[®] could cause interference with reception.
- Should a child seat or a soft assistance seat be used, it needs to be removed after usage.
 - (Keeping it installed may prevent some of the functions from being used.)
- Do not apply force to the remote control.
 It may cause malfunctions.
 To prevent the remote control from being dropped, set it in the hanger when you are not using it. Be careful not to expose it to water.

About rearwash, rear soft cleanse and ladywash


- These functions wash away waste and dirt from a localized area of your body.
- Do not cleanse too much or for too long.
 Doing so may remove normal bacteria,
 which may disrupt the bacterial balance in your body.
- People receiving medical treatment on the relevant areas should consult their doctors before using.

Cleaning instructions

This bidet toilet has been designed and manufactured with great care and attention to detail. If you follow a few simple cleaning instruction you will be able to enjoy its comfort, quality and beauty every day.


- In order to ensure the best possible hygiene the surface of your bidet toilet is closed and pore-free. Do not use sanitary cleaners, household cleaners, benzene, paint thinner, powdered cleaning agents with abrasives or abrasive sponges made from nylon. These products may damage or crack the plastic, and lead to injury or malfunction. Only use mild pH neutral soap for cleaning.
- Wipe plastic areas such as the main unit and remote control with a soft and damp cloth or tissue.
- After cleaning please dry off any residual dampness with a soft cloth.
- Should the toilet seat or cover come into contact with sanitary cleaner or other aggressive cleaning agents rinse the area immediately with clear water.
- When using a toilet cleaner to clean the toilet, wash it off within 3 minutes.
 Seat and cover must be left open. Should vapour from the sanitary cleaner rise from the toilet bowl and get into the main unit, it may cause malfunctions.




Preparation (Using the Product for the First Time)

Insert the batteries

 Remove the remote control from the hanger.




2. Open battery tray and insert two AA batteries.



- When batteries are properly inserted, temperature levels appear on the display of the remote control (back side).
- The display goes out when no button on the remote control is pressed for 5 minutes or more.
- 3. Mount the remote control in the hanger.

If the remote control is secured (for anti theft)

1. Remove the screw from the remote control fixture.



2. Remove the remote control from the hanger.

To secure the remote control again

Tighten the screw.

(Over-tightening may cause damage to parts such as the hanger)

About the batteries


- Use dry cell, alkaline batteries. Follow the instructions below to prevent the batteries from rupturing or leaking fluid.
- When replacing the batteries, use new batteries of the same brand.
- If you will not be using the remote control for a long time, remove the batteries.
- Do not use rechargeable batteries.



Automatic Functions (Cleaning Features)

Various automatic functions are available, such as a toilet lid that opens and closes automatically. Operation under the initial settings is described below.

The toilet cover and the toilet seat will close within about 90 seconds after the user is about 30 cm away from the toilet seat.

- When the room temperature reaches about 30°C or higher, the body sensor may not detect properly. (In this case open manually.)
- When the toilet lid is closed with the remote control or by hand, it cannot open automatically for about 15 seconds. (In this case open manually.)
- When you do not sit on the toilet seat, or when you sit on it only briefly or stand in front of the toilet bowl, it takes about 5 minutes before the lid closes automatically.


Energy Saver Features (Modes)

You can save energy by turning the toilet seat heater to a low temperature (or turning the heater "OFF") during periods when the toilet will be used infrequently.

• It takes about 10 days for the product to determine the periods when it is used relatively less frequently.







Attention!

VICLEAN is an electronic device. Be careful not to let water seep inside or leave detergent in the gap between the main unit and toilet bowl.

- Doing so may damage plastic parts or cause a malfunction: When using a toilet cleaner to clean the toilet, wash it off within 3 minutes and leave the toilet seat and lid open. Wipe off residual cleaning agent in the WC bowl.
- If vapour from a toilet bowl cleaner enters the main unit, it may cause a malfunction. Do not push or pull the nozzle cover or the warm air dryer cover with undue force.
- Doing so may cause damage or malfunction.

Gap between the main unit and the toilet lid (perform monthly)

The toilet lid can be removed for thorough cleaning.



Put the switch on the distribution board to "OFF".

- A Pull the left side outward.
- B Disconnect the hinge from the pin and pull up.
- C Disconnect the right side.

Wipe with a soft cloth that has been soaked in water and wrung-out thoroughly.



Reinstall the toilet lid.

- **D** Join the pin and the hinge on the right side.
- A While pulling out the left side,
- mount by joining the hinge with the pin. (Be careful not to pinch your fingers.)
